We will all need God at some point in life:

:Ecc 4:1 So I returned, and considered all the oppressions that are done under the sun: and behold the tears of such as were oppressed, and they had no comforter; and on the side of their oppressors there was power; but they had no comforter.

Ecc 4:2 Wherefore I praised the dead which are already dead more than the living which are yet alive.

## SEEKING THE COMFORTER

Joh 14:15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.

Joh 14:16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;

Joh 14:17 Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. Joh 14:18 I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.

Demonstrated in Elisha - The man of God. (2 Kings 4:8-17)

- 1. The Shunemite Woman BUILT A RELATIONSHIP- OF GIVING AND COMFORTING
  - a. A great woman of wealth who had need of nothing but there would come a time when she would need a comforter.
  - b. She had no child and her husband was old (not a bright future in those days).
- 2. ADVERSITY COMES WHEN WE LEAST EXPECT IT Her son became sick and died.
- 3. SHE SOUGHT THE COMFORT FROM THE MAN OF GOD.

Joh 15:26 But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me:

Joh 15:27 And ye also shall bear witness, because ye have been with me from the beginning. Act 2:4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.
